*The Members of the Legislative Council and the Members of the Legislative
Assembly having assembled in the Legislative Assembly Chamber in accordance
with the resolutions of the two Houses —*

- 1 The Honourable Shaun Leane MLC, President of the Legislative Council, took the Chair.
- 2 **PERSON PROPOSED AND CHOSEN TO HOLD THE VACANT PLACE IN THE SENATE** — The Chair invited proposals from members of persons to hold the place in the Senate rendered vacant by the resignation of Senator the Honourable Mitch Fifield.

The Honourable Daniel Andrews MP, proposed the Honourable Sarah Henderson as the person to hold the vacant place. He also stated that Ms Henderson was willing to accept the nomination and that he was in possession of advice from the Acting State Director of the Liberal Party of Australia (Victorian Division) that the nominee was the selection of the Liberal Party, the party previously represented in the Senate by Senator the Honourable Mitch Fifield. The proposal was seconded by the Honourable Michael O'Brien MP.

The Chair asked if there were any further proposals and, there being no further proposals, declared that Ms Henderson had been chosen to hold the place rendered vacant by the resignation of Senator Mitch Fifield.
